Supt Gladstone is responsible for implementing the Code of Practice for the Management of Police Information (MoPI) within our Police Force. MoPI sets out how Information Assurance concerns are managed and interpreted within the policing sector. The Force also employs an Information Security Officer, and the role of SIRO is currently occupied by Assistant Chief Constable Alan Pughsley, who has strategic responsibility for Specialist Operations but also chairs the Force Security Committee, which has oversight for Information Security issues.
